RELEASE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

This document will affect your legal rights and liabilities. Please read it carefully before signing.

To: Saltspring Island Sailing Club

I am aware that sailing involves many inherent risks, dangers and hazards, including, but not limited to, sudden changes in the weather, sinking, capsizing, collision with other craft or docks, members or volunteers. I freely give my permission for my child to use the facilities of the Club for the purpose of receiving instruction in the art of sailing, including all its equipment and boats, without parental supervision, and I accept and assume all such risks, dangers and hazards and the possibility of my child or myself suffering personal injury, death, property damage or loss resulting from risks, dangers and hazards.

In consideration of the Club accepting my child into the sailing program and allowing me to access the Club's facilities, for the purpose of delivering and picking up my child, I agree to the conditions outlined below.

1. **To assume and accept all risks, dangers and hazards** in connection with my use or my child's use of the Club's facilities and water craft.
2. **To waive any and all claims** that my child or I may have against the Club, its directors, members, volunteers, agents and representatives (all of whom are collectively known as "the Club") in the event of any accident.
3. **To release the Club** from any and all liability for any loss, damage, injury or expense that my child or I, or next of kin, may suffer, including negligence on the part of the Club.
4. **To hold harmless and indemnify the Club** from any and all liability for property damage, personal injury or death suffered by my child or I as a result of our use of the Club's facilities or water craft.
5. **That this release and indemnity agreement** shall be effective and binding upon my child and me, any of my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators and assigns.
