Participants are informally coached through the responsibilities of each crew position and through the various aspects of racing such as sail trim, upwind and downwind sailing, the basic rules of racing, communication skills for good teamwork, and safety. As this takes place, camaraderie builds and teamwork tightens, contributing to a wonderful sense of joy while on the water and a tremendous feeling of satisfaction at the end of the day.
