

Sailing School COVID-19 Risk Mitigation

SISC Sailing School's priority is to protect health and safety and to respect the BC Health authority Guidelines including hand washing, physical distancing and stay at home if you are at risk.

As per PHO orders, masks are not required. Please feel free to wear a mask if you would like to. Our Instructors will be wearing masks on the docks and when in close contact with students.

Students can choose to sail in a single-person boats or have a partner assigned in a 420 dinghy. Students can also enrol with a sailing partner.

Sailors will come prepared to spend the majority of the time on their boat. Students will have a boat and sails assigned to them for the entire period and should not not share food, drinks or utensils etc.

Our club will have provisions to facilitate good hygiene practices and a cleaning schedule. All of the programs will be held outdoors. Please dress appropriately.

A student drop off/pick up location will maintain social distancing requirements.

Staff members, parents or guardians and children **must not** attend the program if they are sick, even if symptoms resemble a mild cold.

Contact information of all people accessing the facility will be recorded. This contact tracing data will be stored for the summer. All sailors must have an accessible parent or guardian on Saltspring Island that is able to pick up the child if the child develops symptoms, or is repeatedly not adhering to the guidelines.

Cancelation policy: If the classes is cancelled due to insufficient numbers, or if COVID closure are reinstated, a full refund will be issued.
