MARINE WINTERIZATION

This presentation will review and discuss the various elements involved in preparation to winterize most of the pleasure craft types common to our area. The information is based on industry standards as well as cumulative evidence and knowledge gained during our inspection and investigation of numerous and varied actual damages arising from weather related elements. We will also discuss the expectations of marine underwriters with respect to winterization and the vessel owners responsibilities in consideration of insurance claims which may arise from weather related issues.
